Think Tom Waits with a hangover at a Screamin' Jay Hawkins gig in New Orleans!... With six members and a dozen instruments, the band teeters on the brink of destruction while pounding out their bent mix of music, theatre and cabaret. Juke Baritone brings influences from all over and mashes them together magnificently and hilariously into something like a poguesish, Gypsy wedding band with strains of Americana, bluegrass, Aussie convict and Irish folk bleeding into the channels of rock, punk, blues, jazz and everything in between.

**My Sauce Good** Formed in 2008, tasty acoustic group My Sauce Good play unique interpretations of songs ranging from well known to more obscure musical gems in a fresh and original way. Argentinian-born chanteuse Laura Brozky sings in French, Italian, Hebrew, Spanish, Portuguese and English. Dirk Kruihof plays spirited guitar, part Gypsy-swing, part world-bluesman with Bulgarian-born Veren Grigorov on viola and violin.



**Mr Fibby** The noted card shark and duck smuggler ZAVI (aka Sam King) on guitar; renowned drag king and Rusalka SERAPHINA (aka Emma Jasmine Kelly) on violin; perpetual ladies man and carnival refugee BORRACIO (aka Spike Thompson), on cello; and the highly preposterous, rambling biscuit barrel NO IMPORANT (aka Adam Hadley) their story teller - bring you Gypsy inspired tales of love and death.
